



Use the universal mounting bracket (130544) to securely mount the filter assembly to a wall.

Mark the bolt holes, drill, and mount the bracket using proper hardware. When possible, try to securely attach the bracket to a wall stud for support.


Attach the filter assembly to the bracket using the bolts supplied with the bracket.

2nd Stage Coalescing Filter: Replace every six months.



A WARNING

Depressurize unit prior to maintenance or service.

- 1. Disconnect drain tubing (A) from barb fitting located on the bottom of the oil coalescing filter.
- 2. Unscrew tube from filter head.
- 3. Using a 5/16 wrench remove baffle nut from bottom of threaded rod. Remove baffle plates, O-ring and element from threaded rod.
- 4. Reinstall new element, baffle plates, and O-ring (small) in the order shown in figure 3. Screw baffle nut back onto threaded rod making sure there is a proper seal between the element adapter and the baffle plate before tightening. Tighten until snug so there is a tight seal between head, adapter and element. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN BAFFLE NUT!
- 5. Remove and replace outer tube O-ring on tube. Screw outer tube back onto filter head.
- 6. Reconnect drain tubing to the barb fitting located at the bottom of the drain cap.
